## STATIONS & AMENITIES

The **CTrail** Hartford Line includes both new and upgraded stations in Berlin, Meriden, Wallingford, Hartford, and New Haven State Street. Enhancements include passenger focused amenities including:

- Easy boarding—platforms are level with the train floor
- Bicycle racks
- Ticket vending machines (accepts both cash and credit/debit)
- Real-time train information display system
- Electric vehicle charging stations
- Heated platforms for improved safety during colder weather

## PARKING

Parking varies by station. Paid parking is available on an hourly, daily, or monthly basis at most stations. Parking is **FREE** at the surface lots at Berlin, Wallingford and Meriden stations for rail passengers through September 3, 2018.

## MAKING CONNECTIONS

The Hartford Line connects with existing rail services in New Haven, including the New Haven Line (Metro-North), Shore Line East, and Amtrak Acela and Northeast Regional services, allowing for easy connections to Boston, NYC and beyond. **CTtransit** local bus service is available at most stations, and connection to the **CTfastrak** bus rapid transit system is available at Hartford.
